We are always looking for homeowners willing to be part of the Board. This small group and the Architectural Committee do everything we can to keep the monthly dues low and satisfy the needs of the community as much as possible.

Article 5. Board Member Powers and Duties

5.01 Powers and Duties: The Association has been incorporated as a California non-profit mutual benefit corporations and shall have all of the powers and duties of such a corporation. The Association's business and affairs shall be conducted by and through the Board. The Board is vested with all of the Association's powers and duties, except for those powers and duties reserved to the Members either by the Governing Documents or by law. (see Davis Stirling Act).

5.02 Board Composition: The Board shall be composed of (5) Association members or such number as the Association may from time to time determine, as provided by the Bylaws. Board members shall be elected at the Association's annual meeting.

Positions include 1. Chairperson is responsible for oversight, presides at all meetings, see orders and resolutions are carried out and all other duties as may be required. Including budgets, rule enforcement and governmental requirements & management 2. 1st Vice-Chairperson shall act in the place in case of Chairpersons absence. Typically this position is in charge of the clubhouse and pool area, reservations, opening and closing etc. 3. 2nd Vice Chair Manages the common area maintenance including landscaping and gates. 4. Treasure is in charge of financials, overseeing bookkeeping/accounting, taxes, investments, banking and monthly/quarterly reports. 5. Secretary is charged with maintaining Minutes of all meetings, correspondence, etc. One of the most important responsibilities of all Board Members is the power to vote. This responsibility cannot be understated since their vote determines the direction of the HOA.



RESIDENTS RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Lawns are to be watered, mowed and edged.
- 2. Keep weeds pulled.
- 3. Keep driveway free of rust and oil stains.
- 4. Keep fences painted where they are visible from the street.
- 5. Keep street gutters clean. If you have work done on your property, it is your responsibility to make sure that the street and gutters in the area are left clean. If the Association is required to clean up, you may be billed for it.
- 6. Christmas lights must be taken down by January 10th after Christmas.
- 7. Trash collection containers cannot be put out any earlier than the evening prior to the collection day and must be taken in by the evening of the collection day.

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
